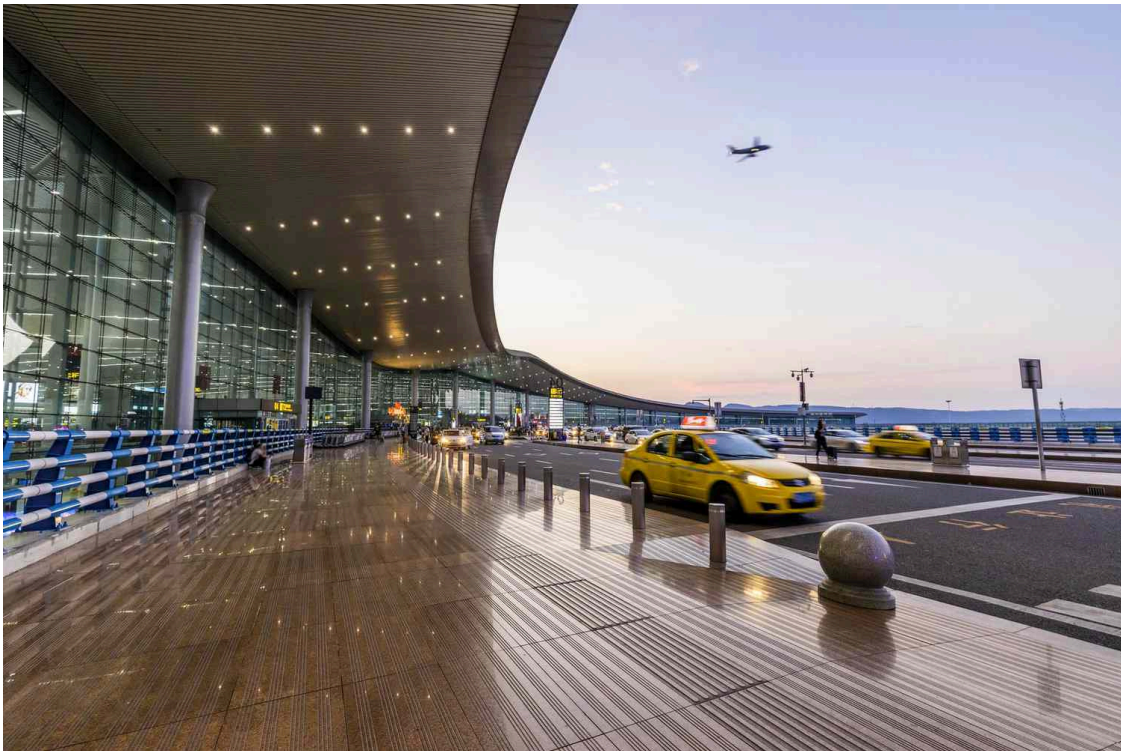


First Time Flying Spirit Airlines from DFW? Here's What You Need to Know

Spirit Airlines flies based on a "Bare Fare" model; it's no-frills flying. Seating is assigned, and while the seats are comfortable enough for short flights, they are not built for luxury. Extra legroom and preferred seating can be had from Spirit for a fee.

Make sure that there will be no in-flight food or drink service for free, so bring your snacks if you must.
